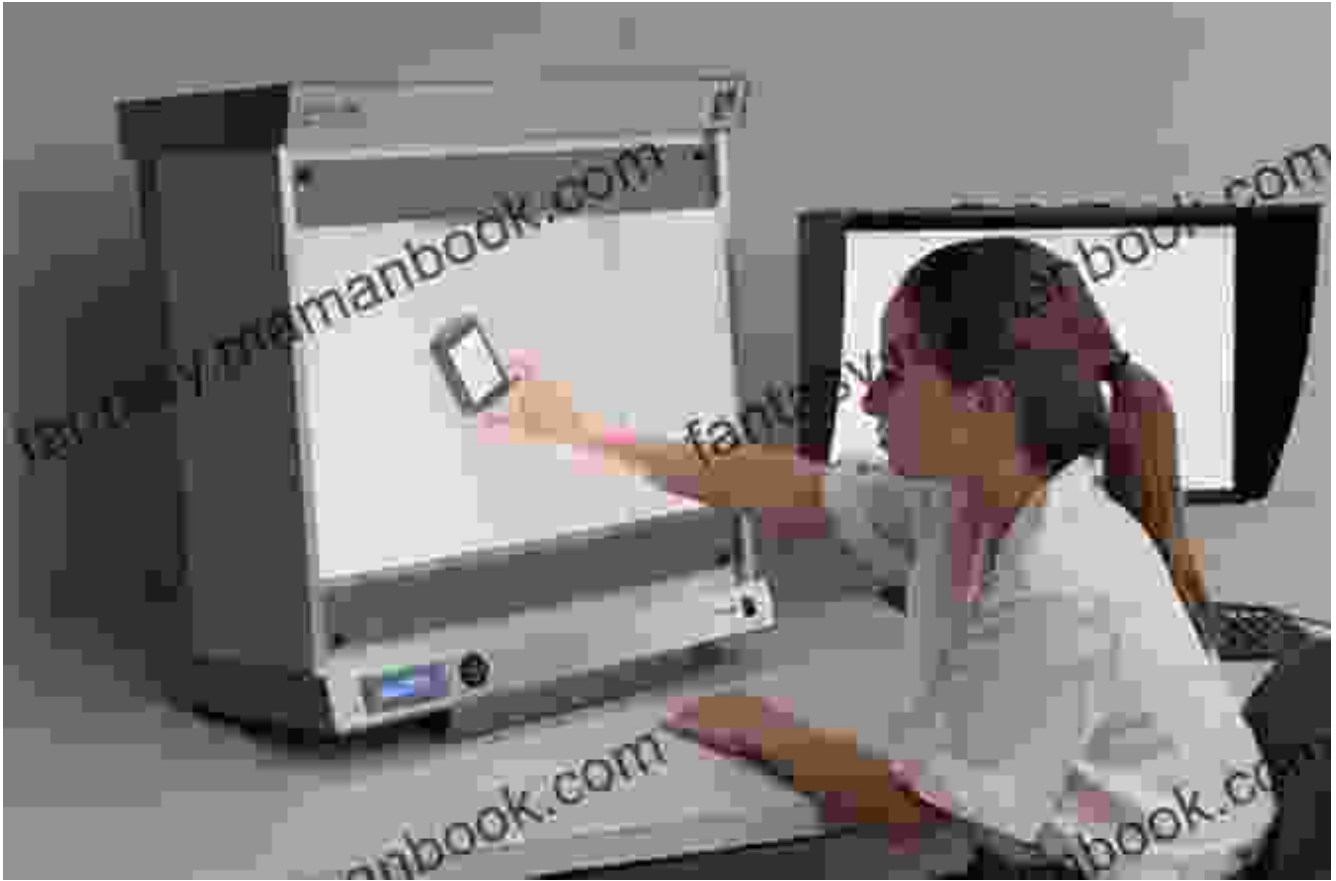

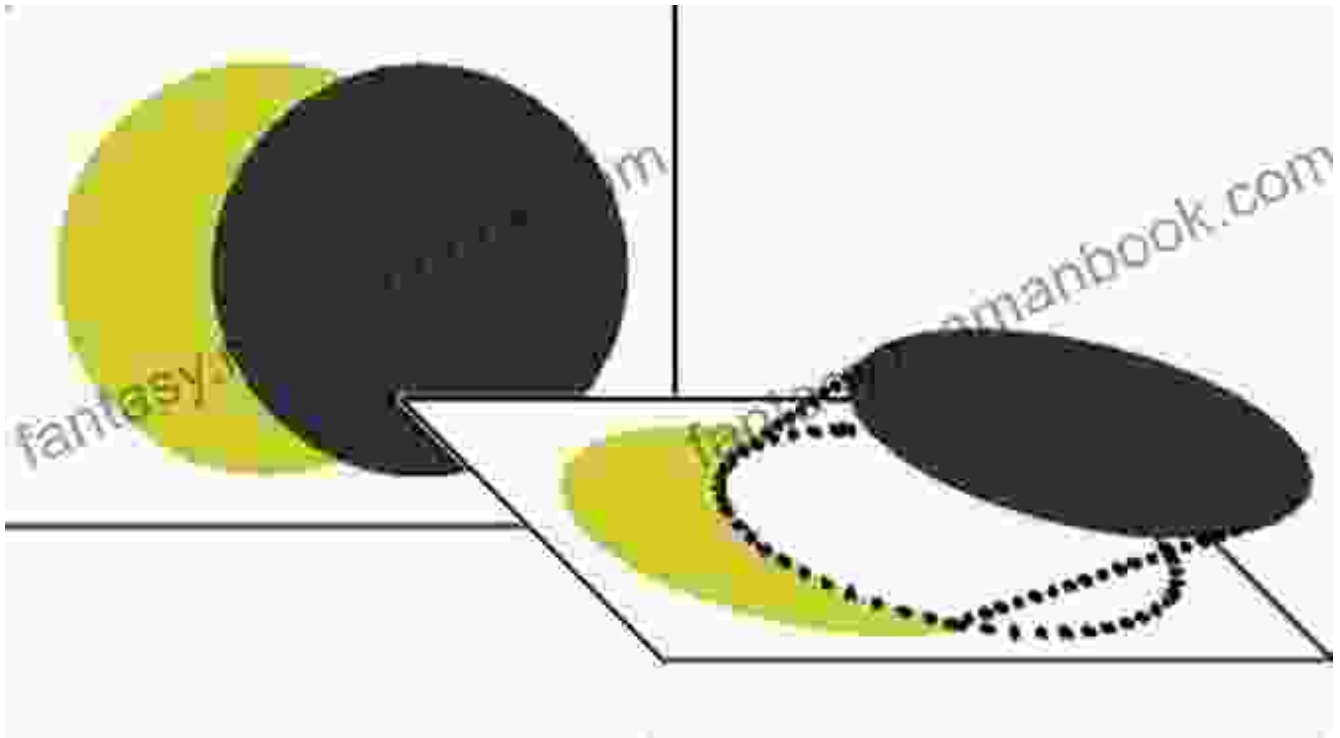

**Step 1.** Create or open an existing design.

**Step 2.** In the menu above the editor, click File or View. Select **Show print bleed**. A border of broken lines will appear close to the edges of your design, which is fixed and cannot be adjusted.

**Step 3.** If you see white gaps around the design edges, **resize or stretch your background to cover them.**

**Step 4.** Stretch elements (that you don't mind being cut) around the edges as well.

**Step 5.** Click on **Share** button and select **Download**. Under **File Type**: Select **PDF Print and Crop Marks & Bleed**. Under **Color Profile**: Select **CMYK**.

Bleeds extend the artwork beyond the trim line to eliminate white edges. Crop marks indicate where the finished piece should be trimmed. Understanding and implementing these elements ensures accurate cutting and assembly.

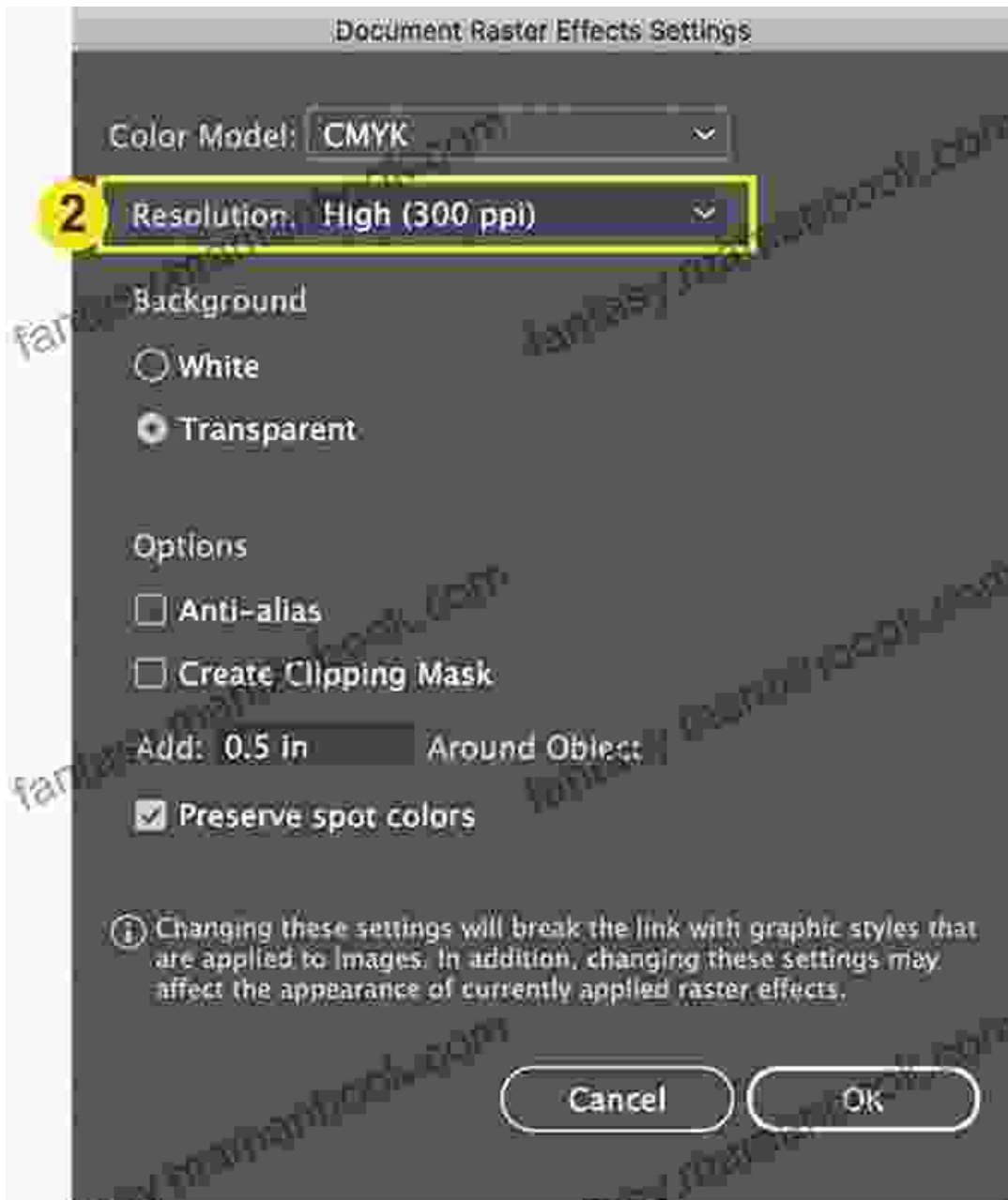

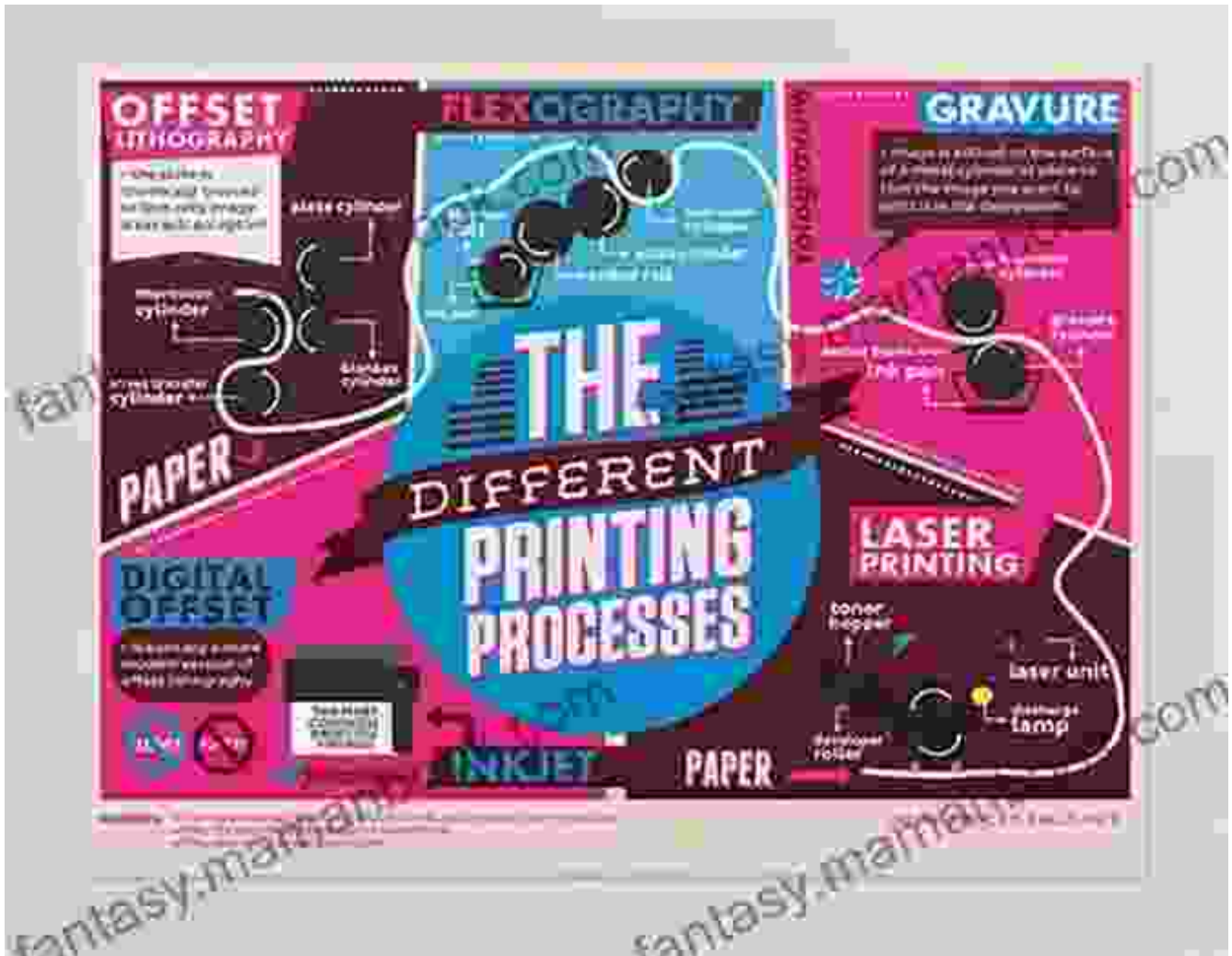

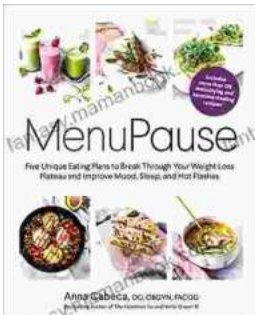
