Materials You'll Need

- Medium weight yarn (worsted weight) in your desired color (approximately 300-400 yards)
- Crochet hook size H/8 (5 mm)
- Yarn needle
- Buttons (optional)

Skill Level

This crochet pattern is suitable for beginner crocheters. The stitches used are basic and easy to master, and we provide clear and detailed instructions to guide you through each step.

Sizing

This crochet pattern is available in six sizes: newborn (0-3 months), 3-6 months, 6-9 months, 9-12 months, 12-18 months, and 18-24 months.

Instructions

1. Make the body:

Chain 91 (or 101, 111, 121, 131, 141) and join with a slip stitch to form a ring. Round 1: Ch 3, work 3 dc in each st around, join with a sl st to first ch-3. (90, 100, 110, 120, 130, 140 dc) Round 2-10: Ch 3, work 2 dc in each st around, join with a sl st to first ch-3. (180, 200, 220, 240, 260, 280 dc) Round 11-14: Ch 3, work 1 dc in each st around, join with a sl st to first ch-3. (180, 200, 220, 240, 260, 280 dc) Round 15: Ch 3, work 1 dc in each st around, sl st in 3rd st from last st. (180, 200, 220, 240, 260, 280 dc) Round 16: Ch 1, work 1 sc in each st around, join with a sl st to first sc. (180, 200, 220, 240, 260, 280 sc) Round 17: Ch 1, work 1

sc in first st, *ch 1, skip 1 st, work 1 sc in next st; rep from * around, join with a sl st to first sc. (90, 100, 110, 120, 130, 140 sc)

2. **Make the sleeves:**

Chain 45 (or 55, 65, 75, 85, 95) and join with a slip stitch to form a ring.
Round 1: Ch 3, work 3 dc in each st around, join with a sl st to first ch-3. (90, 110, 130, 150, 170, 190 dc)
Round 2-5: Ch 3, work 2 dc in each st around, join with a sl st to first ch-3. (180, 220, 260, 300, 340, 380 dc)
Round 6: Ch 3, work 1 dc in each st around, join with a sl st to first ch-3. (180, 220, 260, 300, 340, 380 dc)
Round 7: Ch 1, work 1 sc in each st around, join with a sl st to first sc. (180, 220, 260, 300, 340, 380 sc)
Round 8: Ch 1, *work 1 sc in next 2 sts, ch 1, skip 1 st; rep from * around, join with a sl st to first sc. (120, 147, 173, 200, 227, 253 sc)
Round 9: Ch 1, work 1 sc in each st around, join with a sl st to first sc. (120, 147, 173, 200, 227, 253 sc)
Round 10: Ch 1, *work 1 sc in next 2 sts, ch 1, skip 2 sts; rep from * around, join with a sl st to first sc. (80, 100, 120, 140, 160, 180 sc)
Round 11: Ch 1, work 1 sc in each st around, join with a sl st to first sc. (80, 100, 120, 140, 160, 180 sc)
Round 12: Ch 1, *work 1 sc in next 2 sts, ch 1, skip 3 sts; rep from * around, join with a sl st to first sc. (54, 68, 82, 96, 110, 124 sc)
Round 13: Ch 1, work 1 sc in each st around, join with a sl st to first sc. (54, 68, 82, 96, 110, 124 sc)
Round 14: Ch 1, *work 1 sc in next 2 sts, ch 1, skip 4 sts; rep from * around, join with a sl st to first sc. (37, 46, 55, 64, 73, 82 sc)
Round 15: Ch 1, work 1 sc in each st around, join with a sl st to first sc. (37, 46, 55, 64, 73, 82 sc)

3. **Attach the sleeves to the body:**

Fold the body in half and place the sleeves on each side, matching the underarm seams. Sew or crochet the sleeves to the body.

Finishing

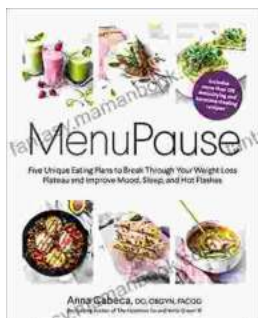
Once you have crocheted all the pieces of the all-in-one suit, it's time to finish it up. Here's how:



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
