- Yarn: Worsted weight yarn in the desired color (approximately 100-150 yards)
- Crochet hook: Size H (5.0mm)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

Gauge

4 stitches per inch

Sizes

- Small Preemie: 12-14 inches
- Preemie: 14-16 inches
- Newborn: 16-18 inches
- 3 Months: 18-20 inches
- 6 Months: 20-22 inches
- 12 Months: 22-24 inches

Pattern Instructions

Small Preemie Hat

- Make a magic ring and pull up a loop. *Insert hook in ring and pull up a loop, repeat around the ring for a total of 6 loops.* Pull the end of the yarn tight to close the ring. (6 sc)
- Round 1: *Insert hook in the next stitch, yarn over, and pull up a loop. (2 loops on hook.) Yarn over and pull through both loops on hook.* Repeat around. (12 sc)
- 3. Round 2: *Insert hook in the next stitch, yarn over, and pull up a loop. (2 loops on hook.) Yarn over and pull through both loops on hook.* Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over, and pull up a loop. (3 loops on hook.) Yarn over and pull through all 3 loops on hook.* Repeat around. (18 sc)
- 4. Round 3: *Insert hook in the next stitch, yarn over, and pull up a loop. (2 loops on hook.) Yarn over and pull through both loops on hook.* Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over, and pull up a loop. (3 loops on hook.) Yarn over and pull through 2 loops on hook. (2 loops on hook.) Yarn over and pull through remaining 2 loops on hook.* Repeat around. (24 sc)
- 5. Round 4-14: Repeat Round 3.
- 6. Round 15: *Insert hook in the next stitch, yarn over, and pull up a loop. (2 loops on hook.) Yarn over and pull through both loops on hook.* *Insert hook in next 2 stitches, yarn over, and pull up a loop. (3 loops on hook.) Yarn over and pull through all 3 loops on hook.* Repeat around. (18 sc)
- 7. Round 16: *Insert hook in the next stitch, yarn over, and pull up a loop.
 (2 loops on hook.) Yarn over and pull through both loops on hook.*
 *Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over, and pull up a loop. (3 loops on

hook.) Yarn over and pull through 2 loops on hook. (2 loops on hook.) Yarn over and pull through remaining 2 loops on hook.* Repeat around. (12 sc)

- 8. Round 17: *Insert hook in the next stitch, yarn over, and pull up a loop. (2 loops on hook.) Yarn over and pull through both loops on hook.* *Insert hook in next 2 stitches, yarn over, and pull up a loop. (3 loops on hook.) Yarn over and pull through all 3 loops on hook.* Repeat around. (6 sc)
- 9. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Weave in ends.

Preemie Hat

1. Follow instructions for Small Preemie Hat, but work Rounds 4-18.

Newborn Hat

1. Follow instructions for Small Preemie Hat, but work Rounds 4-22.

3 Months Hat

1. Follow instructions for Small Preemie Hat, but work Rounds 4-26.

6 Months Hat

1. Follow instructions for Small Preemie Hat, but work Rounds 4-29.

12 Months Hat

1. Follow instructions for Small Preemie Hat, but work Rounds 4-32.

Finishing

- 1. Weave in loose ends.
- 2. Add a tassel or other embellishments if desired.

Tips

- Use a soft and gentle yarn for added comfort.
- Make sure to check the gauge to ensure the hat will fit the desired size.
- If you're working with a different size hook or yarn, you may need to adjust the number of stitches or rounds.
- Feel free to customize the hat with different colors or embellishments.


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
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
