1. Magic ring: 6 sc
2. Inc round: (sc, inc) x 6 [12]
3. Rnd 3: (sc, inc) x 12 [24]
4. Rnd 4: (sc, inc) x 16 [40]
5. Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc) x 10 [50]
6. Rnds 6-10: Sc in each st around [50]
7. Dec round: (sc, dec) x 25 [25]

8. Rnd 12: (sc, dec) x 12 [13]
9. Rnd 13: Dec x 13 [1]
10. Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Ears

Make 2

1. Magic ring: 5 sc
2. Inc round: (sc, inc) x 5 [10]
3. Rnd 3: (sc, inc) x 10 [20]
4. Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing.

Trunk

1. Magic ring: 6 sc
2. Inc round: (sc, inc) x 6 [12]
3. Rnd 3: (sc, inc) x 12 [24]
4. Rnd 4: Sc in each st around [24]
5. Rnd 5: (dec, sc) x 12 [12]
6. Rnd 6: Dec x 6 [6]
7. Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Assembly

1. Position the ears on either side of the head, about one-third of the way down from the top. Sew the ears in place.

2. Attach the trunk to the bottom of the head, centered under the nose.
3. With black yarn, embroider small ovals for the eyes.
4. Stuff the head firmly with fiberfill.
5. Insert your hand into the head and create the puppet's mouth by moving your fingers.
6. For added cuteness, sew on buttons or beads for decoration.

Tips for Success

- Use a medium-weight yarn in a color of your choice to match your elephant's personality.
- For a firmer puppet, stuff it tightly with fiberfill.
- Don't be afraid to experiment with different colors for the eyes and decorations.

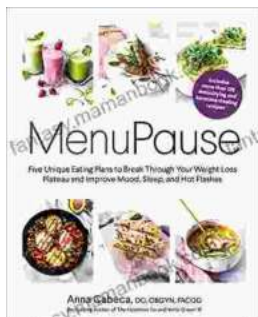
