Row 2: Single crochet (sc) in each stitch across. (140 sc)

Rows 3-4: Repeat Row 2.

Row 5: Switch to white yarn. Sc in the next 34 stitches. (34 sc)

Row 6: Sc in the next 72 stitches. (72 sc)

Row 7: Sc in the next 34 stitches. (34 sc)

Fox Face 1

Row 8: Switch to black yarn. Sc in the next 2 stitches. (2 sc)

Row 9: Sc in the next 10 stitches. (10 sc)

Row 10: Sc in the next 12 stitches. (12 sc)

Row 11: Sc in the next 10 stitches. (10 sc)

Row 12: Sc in the next 2 stitches. (2 sc)

Fox Face 2

Row 13: Sc in the next 7 stitches. (7 sc)

Row 14: Sc in the next 12 stitches. (12 sc)

Row 15: Sc in the next 10 stitches. (10 sc)

Row 16: Sc in the next 7 stitches. (7 sc)

Fox Face 3

Row 17: Sc in the next 2 stitches. (2 sc)

Row 18: Sc in the next 10 stitches. (10 sc)

Row 19: Sc in the next 12 stitches. (12 sc)

Row 20: Sc in the next 10 stitches. (10 sc)

Row 21: Sc in the next 2 stitches. (2 sc)

Rows 22-25: Repeat Row 2.

Row 26: Switch to orange yarn. Sc in each stitch across. (140 sc)

Rows 27-30: Repeat Row 26.

Fox ears

Row 31: Switch to black yarn. Sc in the next 4 stitches. (4 sc)

Row 32: Single crochet 2 together (sc2tog) to decrease. Sc in the next 3 stitches. Sc2tog. (4 sc)

Row 33: Sc2tog. Sc in the next stitch. Sc2tog. (3 sc)

Row 34: Repeat Row 33. (2 sc)

Row 35: Sc2tog. (1 sc)

Rows 36-37: Repeat Row 2.

Fox Nose

Row 38: Switch to white yarn. Sc in 6 stitches. (6 sc)

Row 39: Sc in the next 8 stitches. (8 sc)

Row 40: Sc in the next 10 stitches. (10 sc)

Row 41: Sc in the next 8 stitches. (8 sc)

Row 42: Sc in the next 6 stitches. (6 sc)

Rows 43-46: Repeat Row 2.

Fox Eyes

Row 47: Switch to black yarn. Sc in the 4th and 5th stitches. (2 sc)

Row 48: Sc in the next 2 stitches. (2 sc)

Rows 49-52: Repeat Row 2.

Rows 53-56: Repeat Row 48.

Row 57: Repeat Row 47.

Rows 58-61: Repeat Row 2.

Fox Whiskers

Row 62: Switch to white yarn. Sc in the first 5 stitches. (5 sc)

Row 63: Ch 1, sc in the next 4 stitches. Ch 1, turn. (4 sc)

Row 64: Sc in the next 3 stitches. Ch 1, turn. (3 sc)

Row 65: Sc in the next 2 stitches. Ch 1, turn. (2 sc)

Row 66: Sc in the next stitch. Ch 1, turn. (1 sc)

Row 67: Sl st to the base of the triangle. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Repeat steps for Fox Whiskers 2 and 3.

Assembly:

1. Sew the fox nose onto the center of the white panel.
2. Embroider the mouth and nostrils with black yarn.
3. Sew the fox eyes onto the fox face above the nose.
4. Sew the fox ears onto the top of the fox face.
5. Sew the fox whiskers onto the fox face.

Tips for Customizing Your Fox Scarf:

- Use different yarn weights and colors to create scarves with unique textures and styles.

- Add additional fox faces or embellishments to personalize your scarf.

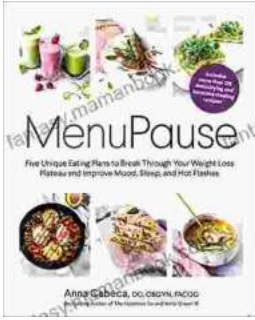
