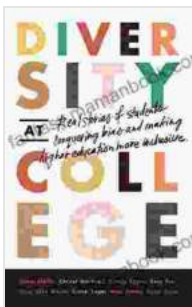

### **Emma: Advocating for LGBTQ+ Rights**

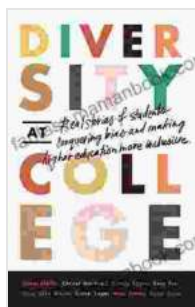

These are just a few examples of the many students who are working to make higher education more inclusive. These students are making a difference in the lives of their peers and in the world. They are inspiring us

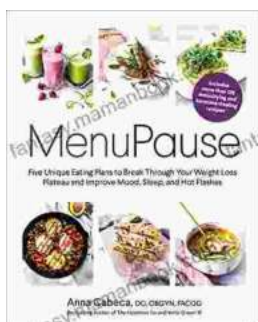
