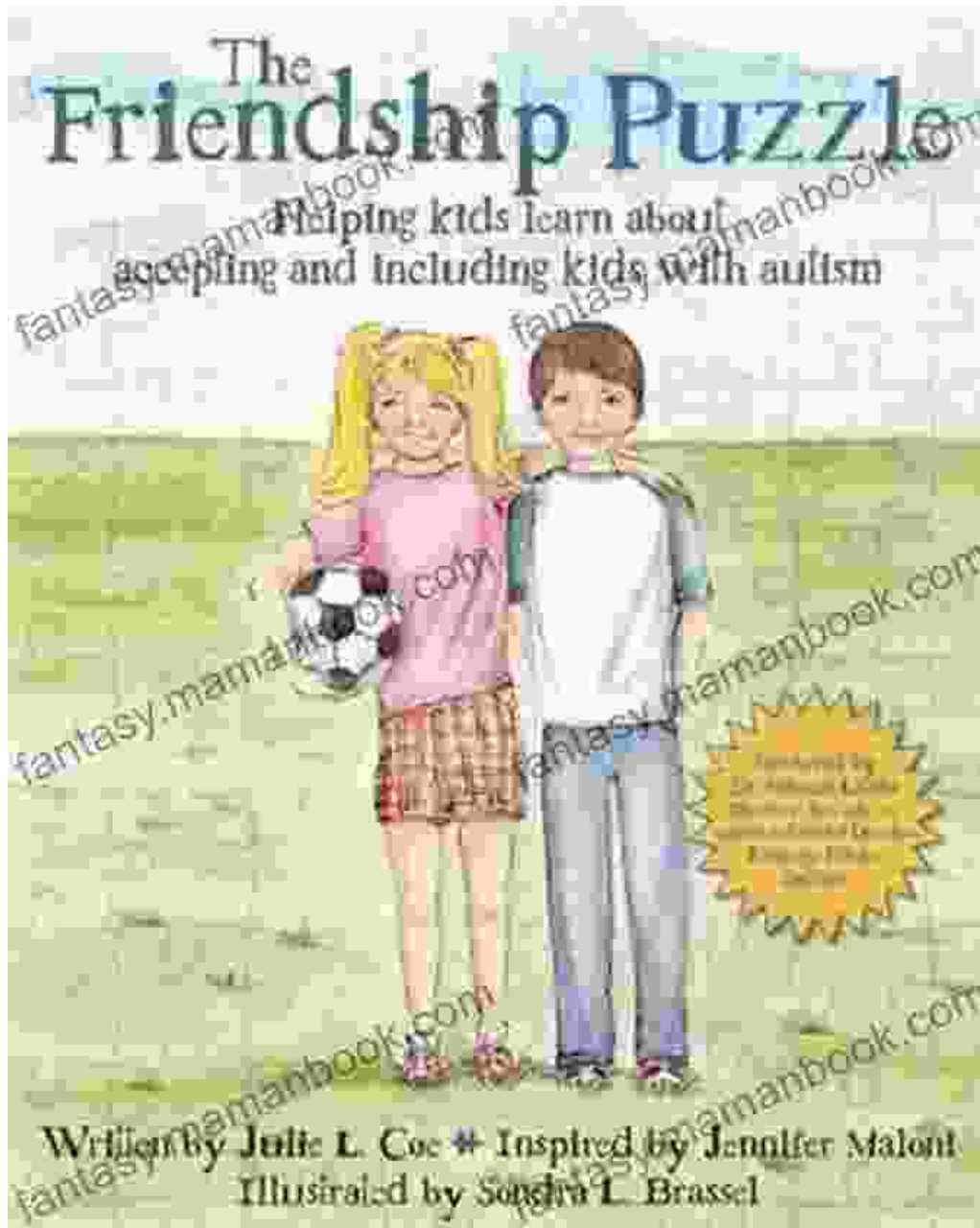
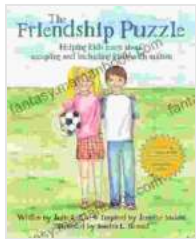


# The Friendship Puzzle: Helping Kids Learn About Accepting and Including Kids

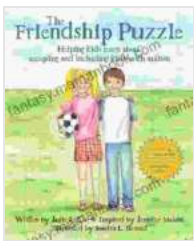

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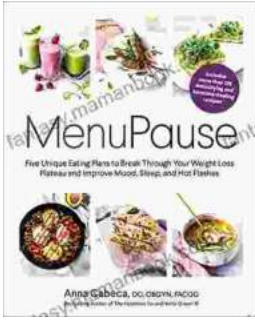
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
