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Materials Required

- Knitting needles size 2.75mm (US 2)
- Double knitting yarn (DK or light worsted weight)
- Tapestry needle for sewing

Abbreviations

- **CO:** Cast on
- **K:** Knit
- **P:** Purl
- **st(s):** Stitch(es)
- **rnd(s):** Round(s)
- **rep:** Repeat
- **inc:** Increase
- **dec:** Decrease
- **sl1:** Slip 1 stitch
- **k2tog:** Knit 2 stitches together
- **p2tog:** Purl 2 stitches together

Instructions

Baby Cocoon

1. CO 60 sts. Join to work in the round.
2. Rnd 1: *K1, P1*; rep around.
3. Rnd 2: *K2, P2*; rep around.
4. Continue in rib stitch (K2, P2) for 3 inches.
5. Shape the cocoon:
 - Rnd 1: *K1, K2tog, P2*; rep around.

- Rnd 2: *K1, P2, K2tog*; rep around.
- Repeat the above two rounds until 12 sts remain.
- CO 32 sts evenly around the edge. Join to work in the round.
- Rnd 1: *K1, P1*; rep around.
- Continue in rib stitch for 3 inches.
- BO all sts.

Papoose

1. CO 90 sts. Join to work in the round.
2. Rnd 1: *K1, P1*; rep around.
3. Rnd 2: *K2, P2*; rep around.
4. Continue in rib stitch for 5 inches.
5. Shape the papoose:
 - Rnd 1: *K1, K2tog, P2*; rep around.
 - Rnd 2: *K1, P2, K2tog*; rep around.
- Repeat the above two rounds until 24 sts remain.
- BO all sts.

Preemie Garment

1. CO 40 sts. Join to work in the round.
2. Rnd 1: *K1, P1*; rep around.
3. Rnd 2: *K2, P2*; rep around.

4. Continue in rib stitch for 2.5 inches.
5. Shape the garment:
 - Rnd 1: *K1, K2tog, P2*; rep around.
 - Rnd 2: *K1, P2, K2tog*; rep around.
- Repeat the above two rounds until 12 sts remain.
- BO all sts.

3mths Garment

1. CO 50 sts. Join to work in the round.
2. Rnd 1: *K1, P1*; rep around.
3. Rnd 2: *K2, P2*; rep around.
4. Continue in rib stitch for 3 inches.
5. Shape the garment:
 - Rnd 1: *K1, K2tog, P2*; rep around.
 - Rnd 2: *K1, P2, K2tog*; rep around.
- Repeat the above two rounds until 20 sts remain.
- BO all sts.

6mths Garment

1. CO 60 sts. Join to work in the round.
2. Rnd 1: *K1, P1*; rep around.

3. Rnd 2: *K2, P2*; rep around.
4. Continue in rib stitch for 3.5 inches.
5. Shape the garment:
 - Rnd 1: *K1, K2tog, P2*; rep around.
 - Rnd 2: *K1, P2, K2tog*; rep around.
- Repeat the above two rounds until 24 sts remain.
- BO all sts.

Tips

- Use a soft and machine-washable yarn for baby garments.
- Check the gauge to ensure the garment will fit the intended recipient.
- Be patient and take your time, especially when shaping the garment.
- If you make a mistake, don't panic. Simply tink back to the error and correct it.

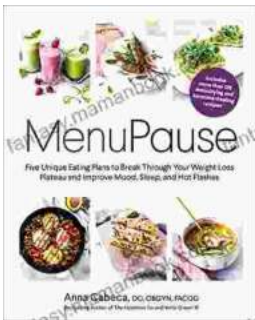
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
