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Materials: Gathering Your Demonic Arsenal

- Worsted weight yarn in black, red, and white
- Crochet hook size H (5.00mm)
- Yarn needle

- Scissors
- Measuring tape
- Optional: Stuffing material for the horns

1. With black yarn, make a magic ring and crochet 12 sc into the ring. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (12 sc)
2. Round 2: 2 sc in each sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (24 sc)
3. Round 3: *sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc* repeat around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (36 sc)
4. Round 4-6: Repeat Round 3. (72 sc)
5. Round 7: *sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc* repeat around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (96 sc)
6. Round 8-10: Repeat Round 7. (192 sc)

Brim:

1. Change to red yarn and crochet 1 sc in each sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (192 sc)
2. Round 2: *dc in next sc, sc in next sc* repeat around. Join with a sl st to the first dc. (192 dc)
3. Round 3: *sc in next sc, dc in next sc* repeat around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (192 sc)

Horns:

1. With white yarn, make a magic ring and crochet 6 sc into the ring. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (6 sc)
2. Round 2: 2 sc in each sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (12 sc)
3. Round 3: *sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc* repeat around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (18 sc)
4. Round 4-6: Repeat Round 3. (36 sc)
5. Stuff the horn with stuffing material, leaving some space at the top for shaping.
6. Continue crocheting until the horn reaches the desired length.

Assembly:

1. Sew the horns to the sides of the main body, above the brim.
2. Embroider or glue on any additional details, such as eyes or a mouth.

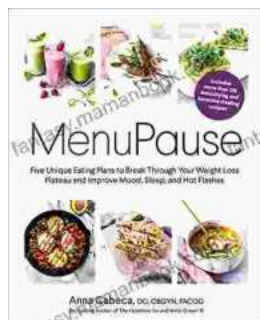
